The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. for seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents to conduct further and fair investigation in case FIR No.45 dated 22.08.2021 under Sections 307, 365, 342, 323, 506, 148, 149 of IPC registered at Police Station Mehal Kalan, District Barnala.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly submits that a final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. already stands filed and that three persons, who were arraigned as accused no.4 to 7, have not been charge sheeted by the police in the the said final report.

However, after arguing vehemently at length, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedy available to him in law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
