Both the courts, on appreciation of the evidence, have refused to pass an order of punishment in exercise of the powers under Order 39 Rule 2-A of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908. This provision enables the court to pass an order if there is willful disobedience of the injunction order passed by the court. Ultimately, the civil suit filed by the plaintiff for grant of decree of injunction has been dismissed, not only by the trial court but also by the Appellate Court.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.
