Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of directions to the official respondents to release the petitioner on parole for a period of 30 days, enabling him to attend the marriage of his sister and to make certain arrangements in the marriage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner stands convicted and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of two years and to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- in case FIR No.209 dated 03.08.2016, under Section 136 Electricity Act, Police Station Ladwa. Being dissatisfied with the said judgment, the petitioner preferred an appeal, bearing No.CRA-S-2279-SB-2017, before this Court and the same is pending adjudication. He further contends that the father of the petitioner expired on 21.09.2021; that his younger brother is 15-

year-old, and that the petitioner is an elder male member in the his family and, therefore, he is to perform the rituals and make certain arrangements in the marriage of his sister. Learned counsel further contends that the sister of the petitioner has already moved a representation dated 01.02.2022 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Jail, Ambala, seeking release of the petitioner on parole for 30 days, but the same is still pending.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the said representation is ordered to be decided within a stipulated time.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ashok Singh Chaudhary, Addl. A. G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Heard.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of hearing, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Jail, Ambala, to decide the representation dated 01.02.2022 (Annexure P-1) moved by the sister of the petitioner, within a period of 10 days from the receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
