Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.166 dated 12.11.2014, registered at Police Station Malout City, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Section 420 IPC.

Vide order dated 05.02.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench, the petitioner had been granted *ad interim* pre-arrest bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 05.02.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined investigation. Moreover, a perusal of the order dated 12.05.2022 passed by learned SDJM, Malout, would show that the petitioner has also furnished the bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. He further submits that on 22.12.2020, challan was presented.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Bohar Singh,

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does not dispute the aforesaid factual position. He also submits that the petitioner has been regularly appearing the trial Court.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 05.02.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
