The limited prayer is to permit the petitioners (plaintiffs) to conclude their entire evidence by granting one additional opportunity.

On the other hand, the learned counsel representing the respondents submits that the plaintiffs have already availed as many as 7 effective opportunities.

The plaintiffs have filed a suit for grant of decree of declaration with a consequential relief of permanent injunction with respect to agricultural land. Some times due to lack of awareness or proper guidance, the party to the suit fails to lead evidence. The rules of procedure are handmaids of justice. The plaintiffs are already undertaking to conclude their evidence on one date.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the trial Court is requested to grant another opportunity to the plaintiffs to produce their entire evidence within a month, from today. This opportunity shall be subject to payment of costs of Rs.5,000/- payable to the defendants by way of demand draft.

Disposed of accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
