The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is petitioner's fifth attempt to get bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.298 dated 17.09.2017 registered under Section 147, 148, 149, 324, 307, 506 IPC and Section 25, 54, 59, of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh.

As per the custody certificate, there are as many as 5 criminal cases pending against the petitioner for having committed various offences under the Indian Penal Code, 1860, apart from the present case. He has also been convicted in FIR No.82 dated 23.04.2010.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition. However, he prays for a direction to the trial court to conclude the trial as the first informant has been declared hostile while deposing in the court.

Keeping in view the aforesaid prayer, the present petition is

dismissed as withdrawn. The trial court is requested to make sincere endeavours for expeditious conclusion of the trial.
