Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.02 dated 01.01.2018 under Sections 307, 452, 323, 324, 325, 326, 148 and 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur, who is in custody since his arrest on 18.10.2019.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Darshan Singh states that vide order dated 25.02.2022, the concession of interim regular bail for a period of two weeks was extended to the petitioner to enable him to perform the ceremonies relating to wedding of his sister, but despite completion of the said period, the petitioner failed to surrender on 12.03.2022.

This facts is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the trial Court has issued arrest warrants against the accused, who is

absconding.

Considering the above background, particularly the conduct of the accused/petitioner, the petition for grant of regular bail is dismissed.
