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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Petitioner is living with her minor son in village Badha, Tehsil and District Fazilka. It is stated that her husband is suffering from depression. The family of petitioner owns one plot. Private respondents have their land adjoining to said plot.

It is the case of petitioner that private respondents are intent of taking illegal possession of plot of petitioner. They frequently interfere with the land in possession of petitioner. On 22.1.2022 at about 5.00/6.00 pm, private respondents illegally trespassed into the plot of petitioner and filled the drain adjoining to the plot with soil. When the petitioner and her family husband requested them not to do so, they were attacked and abused. Private respondents also threatened to kill the petitioner and her family members. The petitioner and her family members have already instituted a civil suit against private respondents. Vide order dated 29.7.2020, the learned Civil Judge, Junior Division, Fazilka restrained respondent No. 4 from interfering into peaceful possession of petitioner and her family members.

It is stated that in May 2020 and March 2021, private respondents had attacked the petitioner and her family members. On that account, petitioner and her family members sent representations to local police and higher officials, but no action thereon has been taken. Regarding the present attack, the petitioner sent representation dated 24.1.2022 (Annexure P-2) addressed amongst others to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka.

Without in anyway opining on the veracity of the allegations made by petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the representation of petitioner dated 24.1.2022 (Annexure P-2) and take such action as may be warranted in law.
