The order passed by the learned District Judge, Kapurthala, assessing the maintenance pendente lite @ Rs.6000/- for the wife and Rs.4000/- for the minor son is being assailed before this Court. The court has found that the petitioner runs a motor garage apart from doing sale and purchase of used cars.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the petitioner has become seriously ill and cannot continue with any of the business.

The order under challenge has been passed on the basis of material produced by the parties before the District Judge. In the case of any subsequent developments, the petitioner is always permitted to file an application for the modification of such order. However, the aforesaid facts cannot be taken in note of for the first time in the revision petition, they need to be proved before the Court.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.
