This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 187 dated 31.7.2021, under Section 420 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar.

Vide order dated 8.2.2022, the petitioner was directed to join investigation subject to complying the condition as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Karam Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is co-operating. He further submits that Section 201 IPC was added and there was no recovery.

As no custodial interrogation is needed, the interim bail granted on 8.2.2022 is made absolute.
