Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondent-department to count the service rendered by petitioner as Science Master on regular basis and ad hoc basis as well from 09.04.1994 to 13.11.1997 towards qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his client would be satisfied at this stage, in case, legal notice dated 23.04.2021 (P-16) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without

adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Director, Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 23.04.2021 (P-16), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
