[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/6, dated 19.09.2019 in CWP No. 40595 of 2018 in case titled as Sulochana Devi and others vs. Chandigarh Administration through its Administrator and another.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the claim of the petitioners as contained in demand notice dated 07.08.2018 having been rejected, he does not press the instant petition as the petitioner has already challenged order dated 06.12.2021 rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in demand notice dated 07.08.2018.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
