This is the first petition for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.77 dated 08.07.2021, registered under Sections 379-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Taragarh, District Pathankot.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the complainant has not been examined as yet.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition, at this stage, with liberty to file fresh petition after the complainant in the present case is examined.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for, with liberty to file fresh petition after the complainant is examined.
