On 23.01.2020 the following order was passed :

“On 17.09.2019, the following order was passed:-

“The instant matter is pending consideration since 2016 with a stay of the proceedings.

A request for an adjournment has been made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Adjourned to 23.01.2020, granting last opportunity to learned counsel for the petitioner to address arguments. Interim order to continue.”

Today again, a request for adjournment has been made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that arguing counsel is in personal difficulty.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 04.05.2020 subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be paid in the Poor Patients Welfare Fund of the Post Graduate

*Institute of Medical Education and Research,
Chandigarh.”*

The matter was taken up yesterday and was adjourned to today on the request of learned proxy counsel appearing on behalf of counsel for the petitioner. Today, though a receipt for payment of Rs.10,000/- has been placed on the file, however, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner despite the matter being called twice.

In view of the above, the Court is left with no other option but to dismiss the present revision petition for non-prosecution.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
