Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to call the petitioner time and again in police station with regard to FIR No.132, dated 13.10.2018, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station P.S. Ghagga.

Notice of motion was issued and learned State counsel had accepted the notice.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Khem Chand states that the police has not been calling the petitioner any more for any investigation in the present case. The challan has already been filed, however, the charges are yet to be framed. There are 17 prosecution witnesses, who need to be examined, once the charges are framed.

In view of the statements made on behalf of the petitioner as well as learned State counsel, no further order is required to be passed in the matter and as such, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
