(The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.)

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing respondents No. 1 to 3 to release the detainee namely Jaskaran Singh who has been forcibly detained by respondent No. 3 with further prayer for appointment of Warrant Officer to visit the spot and get released the detainee from illegal custody.

Pursuant to issuance of notice of motion on 03.02.2022, learned State Counsel appeared and sought time to file reply.

Status report by way of affidavit of Gobinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Mansa, District Mansa has been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 which is taken on record.

In para No. 4 of the reply, it has been mentioned that efforts

mere made to join the petitioner Veerpal Kaur in the enquiry proceedings but she was not found residing on the above given address and it was found that she has left the company of her husband since two years ago and she is missing since then. Moreover, as per the statement of Jaskaran Singh, it was found that he was never taken by the police officials of Police Station Joga, nor does he was ever detained by respondent No. 3 and the present petition is filed by the petitioner on vague grounds for the reasons best known to her.

Today there is no one on behalf of the petitioner to contradict the stand taken by the respondents in the reply.

In view of the above, no further action is required to be taken and the present petition is disposed of.
