Main case

The petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of interim bail in case FIR No.271 dated 10.08.2021 registered under Sections 148, 307, 302, 326, 506, 120-B and 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 27 and 30 Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station IMT Rohtak, Rohtak to enable him to attend marriage of his cousin, which is scheduled for 10.02.2022.

Learned counsel for petitioner contends that the marriage of the petitioner's cousin, namely, Renu is to be solemnized on 10.02.2022 and has invited the attention of the Court to the marriage card

(Annexure P-1). He prays that the petitioner be released on bail.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Sukhdeep Parmar, DAG, Haryana appears and does not dispute the ground raised in the present petition, however, he has opposed the prayer on the ground that the offence is serious and there is every possibility that the petitioner may abscond.

After considering the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the stand of learned State counsel, present petition is disposed off and it is ordered that the petitioner be allowed to attend his cousin's marriage ceremony on 10.02.2022, in custody and after completion of ceremony, he shall be brought back to the prison.

Superintendent District Jail, Rohtak is directed to ensure compliance of this order. It is made clear that all the expenses for travel, etc. shall be borne by the petitioner.
