Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for directing the respondent authorities to count service rendered by the petitioner as Punjabi Mistress in the Punjab Education Department (S.E.) w.e.f. 09.04.1992 to 26.03.1996 as qualifying service for the purpose of calculating pensionary benefits along with all consequential benefits by taking decision on the Legal Notice dated 27.09.2019 (P-10).

Learned State Counsel has produced the copy of order dated 11.08.2021. The same is taken on record and marked as 'X'.

In view of the aforesaid order, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that since grievance of the petitioner stands redressed, thus, present petition be disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
