The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has left the matrimonial home due to her marriage with respondent No.6 against her wishes and on account of this act on her part, she is under threat of being eliminated at the hands of respondents No.6 to 10. In view of the above, seeking protection, a representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) was made on behalf of the petitioner to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, but to no avail.

In the above circumstances, seeking protection of her life and liberty, the petitioner has approached this Court through the present petition.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, particularly the validity of the alleged marriage, the present petition is

disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 – Station House Officer, Police Station Civil Lines, district Bathinda to forthwith consider the aforesaid representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) made on behalf of the petitioner and thereafter take appropriate action on the same as is deemed fit in accordance with law to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.
