The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.227 dated 11.12.2021, under Sections 325, 323, 34 IPC (Section 452 IPC added later on vide DDR/G.D. No.27 dated 14.12.2021) registered with Police Station Talwandi Sabo, Distt. Bathinda.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 04.02.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 04.02.2022, but he is required for custodial interrogation. On a query, he is unable to justify as to why the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 04.02.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the

investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
