The Executing Court after noticing that the Judgment Debtor had deposited more than the amount due in the Court has dismissed the execution petition.

The learned counsel representing the Decree Holder submits that that court delayed the payment.

Once the amount has been deposited in the Court, the Judgment Debtor cannot be made liable to pay interest subsequent to the deposit of the amount in the Court.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.
