The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to decide the representation dated 01.02.2022 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner.

It is submitted that the petitioner is major and respondent No.4 is the father of the petitioner. The father of the petitioner fixed the marriage of petitioner with a boy of his choice for 05.02.2022 and pressurized the petitioner to perform the said marriage. As the petitioner was unwilling to perform the said marriage, she ran away from her house on 01.02.2022 and went to the house of one Gagandeep and since then, she has been residing there. Respondent No.4-father of the petitioner along with other unidentified persons is threatening the petitioner to implicate her in false criminal cases and the petitioner is also apprehending danger to her life. As a consequence thereof, the petitioner moved a representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda on 01.02.2022.

Now, the limited prayer on behalf of the petitioner is that a direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ramandeep Sandhu, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the representation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2–Senior Superintendent of Police, District Bathinda to decide the representation dated 01.02.2022 (Annexure P-1) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representation to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Bathinda for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
