This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to complete the selection process/biometrics verification of the petitioners expeditiously and to declare the result of the petitioners, with a further prayer to direct the respondents to issue appointment letters to the petitioners provisionally, subject to outcome of the FSL report. It is further prayed that the respondents be directed to consider the case of the petitioners and take the final decision on the representation of the petitioners dated 22.01.2022 (Annexure P-21) by passing a well reasoned speaking order within a time bound frame.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioners submits that, at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the representation of the petitioners dated 22.01.2022 (Annexure P-21) and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sunil Kumar Sharma, Senior Panel Counsel for UOI, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation of the petitioners dated 22.01.2022 (Annexure P-21) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
