Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.234 dated 16.11.2021 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860 (Section 326 of IPC 1860 added later on) registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 04.02.2022, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for investigation of the case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harpal Singh corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 04.02.2022 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
