Petitioner has approached this Court with a prayer that he be granted emergency parole for a period of four weeks to enable him to attend the marriage of his nieces (sister's daughters), namely, Preeti and Savita which is fixed for 18.02.2022 at Village Pur, Tehsil Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

It has been asserted that the petitioner being the only maternal uncle (*Mama*) of the brides has to perform marriage ceremonies and, therefore, he be granted the benefit of such parole.

Petitioner had moved an application for the said purpose dated 20.01.2022 (Annexure P-1) to The Superintendent of Jail, District Jail, Bhiwani but till date, no decision thereon has been taken.

The Invitation Card for the marriage ceremony has been appended along with the present writ petition as Annexure P-3 and the report of Panchayat dated 18.01.2022 has also been appended as Annexure

P-3 reflecting the assertions in the petition with regard to the marriage as also that the Gram Panchayat has no objection in case the petitioner is granted the benefit of parole.

In the light of the above, we dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the respondents to consider the application of the petitioner dated 20.01.2022 (Annexure P-1) and take a decision thereon within a period of two days from today and the decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
