The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.4 and to protect the life and liberty.

At the outset, the learned State counsel submits that, in terms of the order of 04.02.2022 passed by this Court, the statements of both the petitioners have been recorded, wherein, it has been stated that there is no threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners, at the hands of their family members or anyone else.
