The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the quashing of the order dated 04.07.2012 (Annexure P-11) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Jagraon (Punjab) in case FIR No.108 dated 17.08.2008 registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Raikot, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1), whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person and for quashing of proceedings relating thereto.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the order dated 05.05.2022, the petitioner has surrendered before the learned Trial Court and his regular bail application is pending adjudication for 19.05.2022.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, given the fact that the trial against the co-accused of the petitioner has already culminated with the conviction of two

persons and acquittal of the others, the Trial Court is directed to conclude the trial against the petitioner preferably within a period of three months.
