At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners restricts his prayer for deciding the representation/legal notice dated 16.11.2021 (Annexure P-8). He would submit that the petitioners would be satisfied in case the said representation is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Arun Kaundal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and would submit that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioners.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take a decision on the representation dated

16.11.2021 (Annexure P-8) of the petitioners and pass a speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law. However, in case such a decision is not taken on the representation/legal notice within the stipulated period, the officer responsible for the lapse would be personally liable to deposit costs of Rs.10,000/- with the High Court Advocates Welfare Fund, Chandigarh.
