ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Vide order dated 21.02.2022, this Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Bhupedner Singh submits that in compliance of the order dated 21.02.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner on the ground that the accused had sold the property and has entered into an agreement with the complainant moreover that he extended the date of agreement which he has been entered with him after the sale of the property and prayed for dismissal of the petition.

4. Be that as it may, this Court cannot analyze this question.

5. Given the nature of allegations, no pre-trial incarceration is required. Without commenting on the case's merits and the circumstances peculiar to this case, the petitioner makes a case for release on bail.

5 A. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 21.02.2022, is hereby made absolute subject to the adhering of following conditions:-

a) Given the nature of allegations and the other circumstances peculiar to this case, the appellant shall surrender all weapons, firearms, ammunition, if any, along with

the arms license to the concerned authority within ten days from today and inform the Investigator about the compliance. However, subject to the Indian Arms Act, 1959, the appellants shall be entitled to renew and take it back in case of acquittal in this case.

b) Within 10 days, the petitioner shall mention details of all assets, held either individually or jointly, including bank balances, fixed deposits, DEMAT accounts, to the Investigator and its copy to the complainant/victim(s).
