Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to refix/revise the pay of petitioners at ₹48,400/- w.e.f. 01.04.2020 and release the arrears along with interest @ 18% per annum.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied at this stage, in case, representation dated 11.11.2021 (P-7) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without

adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Managing Director, National Health Mission, Health and Family Welfare Department, Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 11.11.2021 (P-7), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
