KARAMJIT SINGH, J.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case having FIR No. 22 dated 14.01.2022, registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 341, 506, 509 and 427 IPC and Section 25 (Act No.54) of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner and he has joined the investigation with the police.

The State counsel on instructions from SI Satyawar submits that the petitioner who has joined the investigation with the police is not required for any further investigation or custodial interrogation

The counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has resisted the present petition and submits that the petitioner and his accomplices attacked the complainant and his son and caused injuries to them. On query being put to the State counsel he has admitted that in the present case only simple injuries are attributed to the petitioner.

In view of the above as the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation and only simple injuries are attributed to him, the present petition is allowed without commenting on the merits of the case and order of interim bail dated 11.02.2022 is made absolute and the petitioner is to abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
