By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of a direction qua the transfer of the investigation of the criminal case pertaining to the FIR bearing No.174 dated 14.05.2018 registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala, under Section 419 IPC, to some independent agency or to some senior police officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police for its fair and proper investigation.

Ms. Ambika Sood, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Mr. Vineet Chaudhary, Advocate, has also appeared on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5 in this case and has submitted his Memo of

Appearance and the same has been placed on the file.

At this stage, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Parkash Chand from Police Station Naraingarh, apprises the Court that the investigation has already been concluded in the above-said criminal case and the cancellation report in respect thereof has also been submitted in the competent Court on 16.07.2021.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that in view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition has become infructuous and the same may be disposed of accordingly.
