This is the second petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0034 dated 19.01.2015, registered under Sections 302, 34, 120-B of the IPC and Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar, Gurugram.

The earlier petition bearing No. CRM-M-32788-2020 was disposed of on 06.07.2021, directing the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously within a period of four months by giving two months time to the petitioner to lead his defence evidence.

Learned State counsel at the very outset submits that the case is now fixed for defence evidence and the trial will be concluded soon.

The abovesaid fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the same, the present petition is dismissed.
