CRM-M-3810-2020 (O&M)

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Code of
Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.579 dated
22.06.2018 under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police
Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 06.02.2020, whereby the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“It has been stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the site plan has been produced in the Court but the Civil Court has not given any findings with regard to the genuineness of the document.

On the contrary, it has been stated by the learned counsel for the complainant that forged site plan was prepared, submitted in the proceedings in the Civil Court with an intention to defeat the rights of the complainant in the property.

Adjourned to 22.04.2020.

Meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. The petitioner will join the investigation as and when called for and shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Raj Kaur has stated that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further states that after submission of final report even charges have been framed against the accused vide order dated 25.10.2021.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 06.02.2020 is made absolute.
