This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0027 dated 30.03.2021, registered under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR registered at the instance of complainant-Ravinder Singh, it is stated that the petitioner has given a *gandasi* blow on the right side of his head, however, now the matter has been compromised.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the affidavit of the complainant-Ravinder Singh as well as his father-Harjinder Singh dated 16.11.2021.

Learned counsel for the complainant has admitted that the matter has been compromise between the parties.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate in Court today and as per the same, petitioner is in judicial custody for the last about 08 months and 06 days and is not involved in any other case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties; the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate, concerned.
