The first appeal filed by the petitioner was suffering from delay of 2½ years approximately. The First Appellate Court has dismissed the application for condonation of delay of 2½ years. The petitioner was represented by a counsel before the trial court. He is not an illiterate person. He is working as a Junior Engineer in the Municipal Council, Ambala Cantt. The dispute was with respect to inter-se seniority.

Both the parties have retired from the service on attaining the age of superannuation. The petitioner alleges that his advocate never informed him. The First Appellate Court on appreciation of the evidence has disbelieved the aforesaid plea. There were as many as four private defendants apart from the petitioner herein. The Department was also represented.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petitioner has failed to make out a case for the interference of the High Court in its revisional jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
