Two business entities are prosecuting and defending a suit for recovery. The respondent herein is the plaintiff before the trial Court. The opportunity to lead further evidence of the defendant has been closed by order of the trial Court. The petitioner prays for one last opportunity to examine the chartered accountant subject to the payment of adequate cost. It has been pointed out that the suit is for recovery of Rs.12,69,339/- along with the future and *pendente lite* interest. There are certain facts which are required to be proved by examining the chartered accountant. It is well known that the rules of procedure are the handmaid of justice.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petitioner is granted the last opportunity to examine the chartered accountant, subject to the payment of cost of Rs.5,000/- to the plaintiff which shall be the condition precedent.

Let the chartered accountant be examined on 13.12.2022, i.e. the next date of hearing before the trial Court.

With these all observations, the present petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
