Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail, pending trial in case FIR No.1190 dated 30.12.2016, under Sections 148, 149, 302, 307 IPC, 1860, Section 25 Arms Act, 1959 and Section 3(2)(v) The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station, City Jind, District Jind.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Shri Krishan, has stated that out of total thirty two prosecution witnesses, twenty eight witnesses have already been examined and only four witnesses remain and the case is coming up before the trial court for recording further prosecution evidence on 24.03.2022.
