1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 17.05.2018 in CWP-12595-2018.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 17.05.2018 reveals that CWP-12595-2018 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide legal notice dated 06.02.2018 within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if on consideration, the competent authority arrived at the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners was admissible, then in such eventuality, the consequential relief was to be allowed to them within six weeks thereafter.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the respondent has passed order dated 21.12.2020 accepting the claim of the petitioners, therefore, the petitioners do not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
