Prayer in this petition is for quashing of order dated 01.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed person.

As per allegations made in the FIR No.146 dated 5.12.2015, under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 and 304-B IPC, Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar, registered against the petitioner that while driving his vehicle i.e. I20 car bearing Registration No.PB-10-DM-6495 rashly and negligently on 04.12.2015, he caused an accident and due to which complainant Gurbachan Singh and his son Vishal @ Amit Kumar received injuries and one Ashok Kumar died in the said accident.

After registration of the case, the petitioner was released on

bail on 12.12.2015. After completion of investigation, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. was submitted. The petitioner was regularly appearing before the trial Court till 09.4.2018. Thereafter, the petitioner could not appear before the Court as he was falsely implicated in three other cases and the petitioner thereafter shifted to Uttarakhand.

Because of non-appearance of the petitioner proclamation proceedings were initiated against him and he was declared a proclaimed person vide the impugned order. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had not intended to avoid the process of the Court, rather he is ready and willing to face the trial.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rehat Bir Singh Mann, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Accordingly, the petitioner may appear before the trial Court on or before 28.2.2022. On his doing so, he shall be released on interim bail by the trial Court to its satisfaction.

This shall, however, be subject to depositing Rs.50,000/- to the 'Poor Patient Welfare Fund' of the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh.

The petition stands disposed of.
