Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking issuance of direction to respondent to decide FIR No.138 dated 21.07.2013, registered for offences under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar, Khanna, Police District Khanna, Annexure P-1, which is pending before the Trial Court.

Upon instructions received from ASI, Amar Singh, State counsel submits three persons were named as accused in the FIR, Annexure P-1, including the petitioners, who are parents-in-law of the complainant. He submits that the petitioners have been tried and acquitted vide judgment dated 29.01.2020 by the Trial Court. Still further, he submits that Sukhdeep Singh, husband of the complainant, has been declared as a proclaimed offender. He submits that the petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
