[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel submits that the petitioner has served legal notice dated 4.12.2021 on the respondents but the claim in the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the same in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[3] Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.

[4] Ms. Deepali Puri, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and after perusal of the writ petition states that she has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

[5] Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and

decide the claim made in legal notice Annexure P7 dated 4.12.2021 in accordance with law by taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
