1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 19.12.2019, in COCP-3834-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 19.12.2019, reveals that COCP-3834-2019, was disposed of by inter-alia directing that admitted liability for all the departments except local bodies as existing on 19.12.2019, be cleared by 31.03.2020, strictly according to the priority list maintained. Relevant extract of the same is reproduced as under:-

xxx

It is assured that admitted liability for all the departments except Local Bodies as existing today would be clear by 31.03.2020 strictly according to the priority list maintained.”

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that notice has not been issued in the main case, however, during the pendency of the petition, the respondents have released payment to the petitioner as

per entitlement, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
