ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to COVID-19 pandemic, the petitioner could not deposit the amount of compensation and seeks some more time to comply with the order dated 13.03.2020, passed by the Appellate Court. Counsel further submits that the next date of hearing before the trial Court is 30.03.2022 and in case this Court grants protection he undertakes to appear before the concerned Court.

Consequently this petition is allowed to the extent that the petitioner shall put in appearance before the concerned Court on 30.03.2022 and on which date the Court shall release him on regular bail subject to the condition that the petitioner shall furnish security to the satisfaction of the trial Court. Time to deposit the 25% of the compensation amount is extended till 6/5/2022 (6th May 2022).

Needless to say that no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner till 06.05.2022.

Petition is allowed to the extent mentioned above and all arrest warrants are hereby recalled.
