Present petition has been filed under 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to respondents no.1 to 3 for conducting a fair and impartial inquiry in complaints/representation dated 2.10.2018 (Annexure P-1 colly) sent to respondent no.2.

Notice of motion to respondents no.1 to 4, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rakeshinder Singh Sidhu, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 4.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied, if, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to take a decision on the representation dated 2/3.10.2018 (Annexure P-1 colly) already submitted by the petitioner expeditiously and in a time bound manner.

I find the prayer to be just and reasonable.
