A formal amendment in the plaint has been allowed by the trial Court. Questioning its correctness, the present revision petition has been filed.

The plaintiffs filed a suit for damages of Rs.25,00,000/- on account of defamation while asserting that the defendant falsely implicated the plaintiffs in FIR No.341, dated 11.06.2008, registered under Section 406/420 IPC. In the suit, it has been alleged that the allegations referred to in the FIR were absolutely false and misleading.

The only amendment allowed by the trial court is to permit the plaintiffs to incorporate two words, namely, 'malicious prosecution'. Such amendment is formal in nature and does not affect the rights of the parties.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
