MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to open the sealed cover and promote the petitioner from Assistant Food Supply Officer to the post of Food Supply Officer.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case, representation dated 29.12.2021(P-10) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with

direction to respondent No.2-Secretary, Department of Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 29.12.2021 (P-10), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
