AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The petitioner is before this Court seeking regular bail in FIR No. 124 dated 07.06.2020, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 341 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh.

As per the allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of Pawan Kumar @ Pana on 17.6.2020, Biru @ Kancha, Monu, Dalip and three boys blocked the way of complainant and his friend Mandeep @ Guli. There was an altercation. The complainant party were inflicted injuries. As per the role attributed to the petitioner, he was a participant in the occurrence and inflicted injuries.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 24.7.2020, no recovery was made from the petitioner, co-accused was granted bail by this court. He further submits that the injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature.

Learned counsel for UT, Chandigarh opposes the prayer for grant of bail, however he is not in a position to distinguish the parity of the petitioner vis-a-vis the co-accused so far as grant of bail is concerned.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the nature of allegations, custody period, no recovery was made from the petitioner and conclusion of trial is likely to take time, the petitioner is granted bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
