This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India in the nature of '*mandamus*' directing the learned Principle Judge, Family Court, Sirsa, to decide the petition under Sections 7 and 12 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, bearing No. 45 of 2019, tilted as Sandeep Bhatia vs. Leenu (copy Annexure P-2).

The case has been called twice. However, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

It is evident that the matter has remained pending since January 27, 2020. There has been no representation on behalf of the petitioner for the last 03 dates successively.
