The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to count the entire service rendered by the petitioner from 01.06.1984 to 31.03.1986 and from 14.09.1986 to 28.03.1989 in Khalsa Senior Secondary School, Bathinda against leave vacancy for the purpose of increments and pensionary benefits with all consequential benefits treating as qualifying service as the petitioner worked against an aided sanctioned post, for which, representation dated 21.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) has

also been submitted before the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the representation dated 21.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay.
